They have also been very helpful with projects in the store, creating a second classroom, remodeling the storeroom, and finding the water heater!



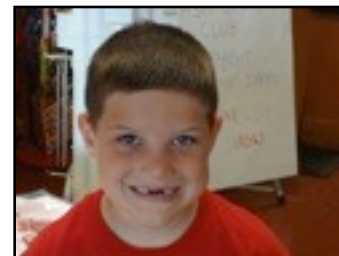

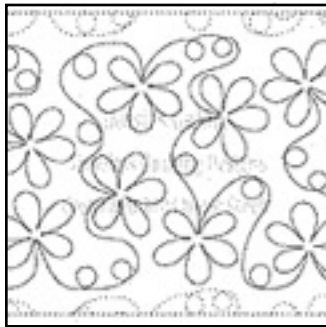
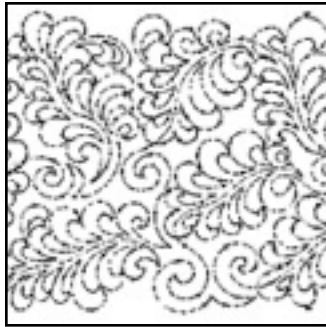

Bottom Design: *Daises Galore*

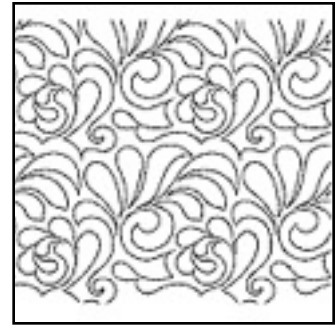

Hyderhangout currently has at least 50 examples of the available quilting patterns in-house. Other custom patterns can be ordered.

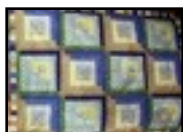


July SPOTLIGHTS
