will be a highlight of your Show experience.

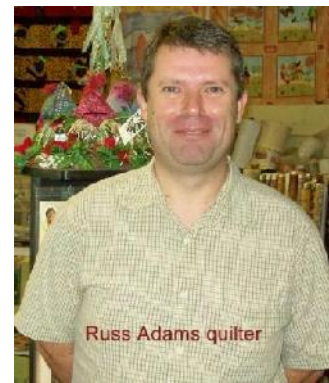
## Georgia Quilt Show Class
