Basic Supplies: Sewing machine in good working condition plus
*a free-motion foot and basic sewing kit

Additional Supplies:

A McKenna Ryan Pattern

Fabrics I would suggest *batiks or *McKenna Ryan

Fabric.

*Spray starch

*An Applique pressing sheet (*Nifty notions is my favorite)

* ½ yd Tear-away stabilizer or muslin (for the back)

2 yds **paper-backed *fusible web** (I like *Heat n' Bond-lite)

*Matching threads

*Superiors Monopoly thread

Suggested Homework: with a pencil, Trace the pattern pieces from the McKenna Ryan supplied **patterns** onto the paper side of the **fusible web**. Number and title each piece. Don't cut them all apart. If you are hesitant about this step, e-mail or call me. Don't stress.
