Class Description:

This class combines fusing appliqué with decorated hand stitches. It is a fast and fun way to make a wall quilt..

Suggested Book: *Fanciful Stitches, Colorful Quilts* by Laura Wasilowski

Fabric Selections:

Batting, 18 x 24 inches.

Fusible (steam a seam 2) at least two yards

Fat quarters, fat eights or scraps of several different fabrics that coordinate. Plan to use some fabrics that “read” as solids. Have at least ten different fabrics.

Batiks work beautifully. Quilt store quality fabrics are needed.

Supplies:

scissors

Cutting board, rotary cutter (optional, rotary blades that cut a decorative edge)

*Embroidery needles (5/10)

*Pearl cotton or embroidery floss in several colors
