

MACHINE QUILTING II - SUPPLY LIST (Revised 12/2011)
6 Hour Workshop * Carol Meka (480) 998-4992

1. Sewing machine in top working order, attachments, manual, machine oil, etc.
2. Basic sewing supplies: pins, scissors, note pad, etc.
3. Darning foot – A MUST – used for free motion.
4. Walking foot – A MUST
5. Feed dog cover (if feed dogs do not drop on your machine)
6. #1 (1”) rustproof safety pins; USED FOR BASTING – pkg. of 100
7. Portable lamp used for additional light (only if you have one)
8. Extension table for machine (only if you have one)
9. Pillow (to sit on – tables are often too low)
10. Sewing Machine Needles: Schmetz Quilting #75 or Schmetz Universal 80/12 – bring at least one package
11. Thread: #50 - 100% Cotton; 1 large spool
Color: Mettler #844 or Aurifil #2314 or any other tan that allows you to see your stitches.
12. Fine point disappearing ink pen – purple.
13. Bobbins; Please have 3 or 4 filled.
14. Fabric for samples: 3 yards unbleached muslin – 45” wide
15. Batting: Thin cotton batting such as Warm and Natural, Quilters Dream, Hobbs Heirloom.
16. One pair comfy socks.

CLASS PREPARATION

PLEASE HAVE THE FOLLOWING CUT, PRESSED AND BASTED PRIOR TO CLASS:

- 1) 14 – 14” squares of muslin & 7 – 16” squares of batting
- 2) 2 – 20” squares of muslin & 1 – 24” square of batting

BASTING: Layer & Baste the pressed muslin with batting in between, making sandwiches. Baste every 5” using #1 safety pins.

MAIN PROJECT: This will be a fun learning project and a time to use some of those fabrics stashed at home. Charm packs also work great.

TOP: 25 – 5” or 6” squares of many different fabrics, but using a color theme. Please include a mixture of the following:

Solids – light and dark - (at least six solids)

Prints – large and small – anything goes

Values – light, medium and dark

Border: Approx. 2 – 3” on each side.

Piece together squares 5 across and 5 down. Add borders to each side.

Finished Size: Approx. 32” or 36” square.

BACKING: Use a busy print with same color theme as top. Finished size: 2” larger on each side than the top. Approx. 36” x 36” or 40” x 40”.

BATTING: Same size as backing

THREAD: Purchase during class

BASTING: After pressing top and backing, layer & baste using 2 pins/ square and stagger in border
We’ll have Show & Tell. Please bring any quilts you have been working on. Please be familiar with your sewing machine. Know how to adjust the upper and lower tension, drop or cover feed dogs, fill bobbins, etc. Please call if you have any questions.
