Basic Supplies:

PATTERN: Cardinals by MH Designs

Sewing machine in good working order with an open-toe foot

Good quality thread, 100% cotton—neutral color—Aurifil (orange spool) or Mettler 50/3

Machine needle 90/14 Universal or Sharp

Basic sewing kit (fabric scissors, pins, seam ripper, etc.)

Rotary cutter, mat, and ruler

Add a Quarter ruler

Fabric glue stick

Paper scissors

Optional: Small iron and ironing mat

Note: Bring your pattern and be sure to make a copy of it prior to the class if you do not want to use the original for this class.

Fabric Requirements: (Note: the pattern lists the requirements, but I would bring a piece a little larger than noted in case you have a mishap.)

Background Fabric: ¼ yard (Note: I bought 1/3 yd. to be on the “safe” side.)

Female Cardinal: 2 ½" x 10"

Male Cardinal: 2 ½" x 11"

Beak Fabric: 1" x 6"

Black Fabric: 1" x 9"

Twig Fabric: 1" x 27"

Border/Binding Fabric: ¼ yard

Note: Pearl cotton for twigs and berries listed on pattern
