ADVANCED BASIC BEGINNING QUILTING SUPPLY LIST

Sharron & Karen work at Quiltz on Monday, Tuesday, and Friday if you have any questions regarding this class or would like their help in selecting your fabric. You will need your sewing machine, supplies, and fabric at the first class.

Class Description:

The goal of this six-week class is to build on the skills learned in the Beginning Quilting by Machine class, introduce new techniques, and empower you to try more sophisticated projects. Although this class is designed to build on techniques taught in the beginning class, it's suitable for anyone comfortable with a rotary cutter and a 1/4" seam.

Students' Introduction

Welcome to a class that will give you a little more of a challenge than a beginner's class. You will be introduced to the following: flying geese, quarter-square triangles, square in a square, curved piecing, setting blocks on point, sashings, cornerstones, and mitered borders. There will be homework each week that must be completed before the next class.

Class Supplies:

Sewing machine in good working condition with a 1/4" foot and manual. You must be comfortable with using your machine! **Practice sewing before class.**

- 80/12 Universal sewing machine needles
- Rotary cutter with new blade
- Rotary cutting mat
- 6" x 24" ruler
- 6" x 12" ruler
- 1" x 6" or 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" ruler (optional)
- 12 1/2" square ruler
- 100% Cotton neutral thread, 50 weight, new
- Bobbins
- Optional but VERY helpful: small cutting mat or rotating mat, small rotary cutter
- Basic Sewing Kit: Small scissors; fabric scissors; seam ripper; thin silk glass head pins; tape measure; marking pencils
- A loose-leaf notebook and page protectors
- Notebook paper and pencil
- 26" Batting square (to lay out and transfer blocks)

Fabric:

We recommend that all your fabric be purchased at Quiltz. You will get a 20% class discount off all purchases for class.

1 2/3 yd. - Color A – Blocks and outer border

1/2 yd – Color B – Blocks

1 1/8 yd. – Background – Blocks and setting triangles and corners

1 1/2 yds. – Sashing, Inner border, and Binding

1/8 yd – Cornerstones

Special notes:

There will be homework with this class!

Attached are the cutting instructions that should be completed before the first class.

Cutting Instructions

Before cutting anything else! Cut your outer border from Color A and your inner border from your sashing fabric!

- **Outer Borders** - Cut four 4 1/2" strips along the selvage for unpieced borders.
- **Inner Borders** - Cut four 3 1/2" strips along the selvage for unpieced borders.
- **Setting Triangles** - Cut one 18 1/2" squares from Background
- **Setting Corners** - Cut two 9 3/8" squares from Background.
These need to be cut before the block pieces to ensure they have a big enough piece to get those two 18 1/2" squares cut.

Place all pieces in marked plastic bags separated by blocks.

Star Variation Block:

- Two 4 7/8 squares of Color A and background
- Two 5 1/4" squares of Color B and background
- One 4 1/2" square of Color A

Aunt Dinah's Block:

- One 4 1/2" square of Color A
- Four 2 1/2" squares of Color A
- Two 5 1/4" squares of Color A
- One 5 1/4" square of Color B
- Two 4 7/8" squares of Color B
- One 5 1/4" square of background
- Four 2 7/8" squares of background

Pinwheel Block:

- One 7 1/4" square of Color A and background
- One 2" strip of background; from this strip, cut four 6 7/8" sections
- Two 5 3/8" squares from Color B

Drunkard's Pinwheel Block:

- Drunkard's Pinwheel will be cut in class.

Martha Washington Star Block:

- Four $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares from background
- One $7\frac{1}{4}$ " square from background
- Two $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares from Color B
- Four $3\frac{7}{8}$ " squares from Color A
- One $4\frac{1}{4}$ " square from Color A
- One $4\frac{1}{4}$ " square from Color B
