Students will need: sewing machine in good working order with a straight stitch foot and a free-motion foot, and a basic sewing kit including small, sharp scissors.

More Supplies:

½ yd. tear -away stabilizer

Iron-on paper-backed fusible web.

(I like Heat n' Bond Lite)

Fabrics: ¼ yds or Scraps of batiks for water, ground, cactus etc.

A SKY fabric.. Does not need to be clouds

Matching threads for bobbins

Superior's Monopoly thread

Spray starch

Freezer Paper

Permanent marker
