Supplies: Basic sewing kit

Sewing machine in good working condition with a regular sewing foot plus *a free-motion foot

1 yd muslin

Sharp scissors

Small Rotary cutter and mat

Long pins

Fabric glue *I like Roxanne's or Aileen's*

Threads

Fabrics: *the easiest way to choose fabrics for this project is to start with two large motif or inspirational fabrics (maybe with a theme) and then coordinate 15 to 20 light , medium and dark valued fabrics , in a variety of textures, prints and solids. OR... I can help with fabric selection during class.*

Fabrics: ½ yd. each of two large motif /themed home décor fabrics

15-20 ¼ yds or more of colors from the large motifs
(these could be Quilter's cottons)
In Light, medium and dark values, in patterns, prints and textures
