Stitched follows three quilters racing to complete their entries for the International Quilt Festival, the largest quilt show in the nation. The Houston show draws more than 50,000 quilters including three artists: Caryl Bryer Fallert, Hollis Chatelain and Randall Cook who spark hot debates with their groundbreaking work.

Learn confidence and techniques for basic machine quilting. Stippling and machine quilting supplies. Try out different needles and threads to see how they work with your machine.
