Supplies you will need:

- Sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a Bernina.
- Basic sewing kit to include: chalk marker, water-soluble fabric marking pen, long strong straight pins (invest in quality straight pins with glass heads), pincushion, seam ripper, seam gauge, needles for hand sewing and extra machine needles.
- Rotary cutter and mat, ruler, scissors, pencil for notes.

Items for Class:

- Pattern for class (I found the pattern sizing to be accurate)
- Fabric for class. (Refer to pattern for correct amount) Cotton or rayon fabrics work well for this project.
- 1 Yard of fusible cotton interfacing.
- Pattern Ease for tracing pattern, a good pencil to trace with.
- Buttonhole foot
- Button foot if using non shank buttons.
- Measuring Tape
- Thread to match fabric
- Bring a lunch or plan on 45 minutes for a lunch break.

Before coming to class:

- Pre wash fabric, dry and press with spray starch.
- Read through the entire pattern, just to become familiar with it. We do not expect you to understand all the details.
- Trace or cut your pattern size. If unsure of size, you can do this in class.

Class Policies:

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.

- Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
