



## Embroidery Playtime

### Quilting with the Embroidery Machine

#### **Supplies you will need:**

- Your embroidery machine cleaned and oiled.
- All of your accessories including hoops and templates.
- Several filled bobbin for the first class, one **empty** bobbin for the second class.
- Needles, size 80 universal, if you are using metallic thread be sure to use a topstitch or metafile needle. You will need to bring extra needles.
- Embroidery designs that have outlines, as they can be used for quilting in the second class.
- Embroidery threads, as needed for your design.
- A pieced wall hanging. If you have never pieced a quilt top, a simple 9 patch with plain squares works well. If you do not wish to make a wall hanging, a pieced table runner that has room for both quilting and embroidery will also work.
- Backing fabric and batting, 2" larger than your project will be needed for the second class.
- Ultra Clean 'N Tear stabilizer and Aqua Film stabilizer. You will be using quite a bit of both, so please bring your rolls.
- A chalk marker and ruler
- For the second class, you will need scrap fabric and scrap batting.

#### **Class Policies:**

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
