



Embroidery Camp – Tree-Mendously Red

Monday through Friday,
June 20th through 24th, 10:00-4:30

Supplies you will need:

- Embroidery machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and several new needles. Be sure to bring your instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a BERNINA.
- Extra machine needles, size 80 Universal
- Basic sewing kit to include: water-soluble fabric marking pen, long strong straight pins, you will need both glass head and flower head pins, pin cushion, seam ripper, seam gauge, needles for hand sewing.
- Machine cleaning supplies, including oil, you will be doing a great amount of sewing and you will not be taking your machine home at night.
- All of your hoops and templates for those hoops, along with visa vese pens to mark on the templates.
- “Tree-Mendously Red” design pack by The Stitch Connection, available at the store.
- Feet:
 - #37, quarter inch foot for piecing
 - Your embroidery foot
 - Walking foot, optional
- Thread:
 - You will need to bring the color of thread that you are going to use as your color (blue, red, black or whatever color you choose) for the theme of the quilt.
 - You will also need to bring thread for the quilting of the background. I used white. The quilting is done first so you must have this thread on the first day of camp.
 - Regular sewing thread for the construction of the quilt.
 - Bobbin thread (this project takes quite a lot of bobbin thread so bring the spool).
- Stabilizer: Ultra Clean ‘N Tear in the widest roll you can purchase as it will be the most economical and you will be using quite a bit of it.
- Rotary cutter ruler and mat, class room size as we will need it to square up the blocks after they are embroidered.

- Stiletto
- Scissors, for fabric and small ones for threads.
- Fabric:
 - Background, 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards
 - 1/8 yard each of 14 different fabrics in the same color family
 - 1 fat quarter each of 4 different greens
 - Scraps of browns
 - 1/2 yard for inner border and binding
 - 1 $\frac{5}{8}$ to 2 yards for backing (you can wait on this until the quilt assembly is completed)
 - 3 yards of batting. If you have scraps you can use some for the embroidery, but then you will need a piece that is 45" by 54" for the overall quilt sandwich, if you decide to do double batting.

Please do not cut fabrics ahead of time.

You will need to load all of the designs to a stick or your machine before coming to class.

If you have a machine other than a BERNINA, you will need to let the store know ahead of time and it would be a good idea if you brought your laptop so that we can load the quilting designs to your machine.

Class Policies:

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
- As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class.
- Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
