Supplies you will need:

- Sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a Bernina.
- Basic sewing kit to include: chalk marker, water-soluble fabric marking pen, long strong straight pins (invest in quality straight pins with glass heads), pincushion, seam ripper, seam gauge, needles for hand sewing, extra machine needles and a ruler.

Additional Items needed for class:

- Kit, includes booklet and panel
- Batting to fit panel, plus ¼ yd ,Hobbs Heirloom or low density batting,
- Backing fabric to fit panel plus ½ yd backing fabric for binding.
- Thread to match backing. Invisible thread for top. Suggest YLI clear or smoke. You can also use matching thread if desired.
- Erasable marking pencil that will show up on light fabric.
- 14" x14" quilt sandwich either muslin or solid color for practice.
- Walking foot
- Single Stitch plate for your sewing machine (optional)
- Free motion or darning foot
- Tray table for your machine

Prior to class:

- Layer and pin your quilt sandwich, leaving batting and backing extending approximately 2" on all sides.
- Review the beginning of the book pages 1 thru 3
- Look at CD templates on computer if you have these.
- Bring binding fabric to finish quilt if time allows

Class Policies:

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
