Supplies you will need:

- Sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a Bernina.
- Basic sewing kit to include: chalk marker, water-soluble fabric marking pen, long strong straight pins (invest in quality straight pins with glass heads), pincushion, seam ripper, seam gauge, needles for hand sewing and extra machine needles.
- Two fat quarters, one red, one brown
 - If you get 1/3 of a yard of red you do not have to piece your binding.
- Thread: Red and white
- Sew Easy guide
- Baby rick rack
- ¼" foot, if you have one
- Walking foot, if you have one
- Embroidery floss, red, black & white
- Small embroidery hoop
- Embroidery needles
- Small ruler
- One 9" square of Insul-brite
- One 9" square of batting

Prior to class:

- Cut from red fabric:
 - One 9" square
 - Two 2 ½" strips for binding
 - o Three 2 ½" squares
 - \circ Two 1 ½" by 8 ½" strips
 - o Three 1 ¼" by 6 ½" strips
- Cut from brown fabric:
 - Six 2 ½" squares

 Have your 9" squares of batting and Insul-brite cut.
