



## Photo Memory Quilts

### Supplies you will need:

- **Memories on Fabric** by Sue Hale
- Crafters Images Photo Fabric 100% Cotton Poplin printer sheets
- Your photos for the quilt, printed on paper, and on a memory card or other digital media, i.e. CD or USB stick
- 2 or 3 fat quarters to coordinate with your photos
- Fast2Fuse or batting for size of your quilt
- Embellishments pertaining to the subject of your quilt
- Lite Steam-A-Seam or Steam-A-Seam 2 for fusing your fabric photos to the quilt front
- Non-stick pressing sheet or parchment paper
- Sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a Bernina.
- Extra machine needles
- Basic sewing kit to include: chalk marker, water-soluble fabric marking pen, long strong straight pins (invest in quality straight pins with glass heads),
- Optional - pincushion, seam ripper, seam gauge, needles for hand sewing
- Rotary cutter and mat

### Before coming to class:

- Decide on photos for the quilt. Print them out on paper to use for laying out the quilt while the fabric photos are drying.

### Class Policies:

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
