Supplies you will need:

- Sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a Bernina.
- Extra machine needles
- Basic sewing kit to include: chalk marker, water-soluble fabric marking pen, long strong straight pins (invest in quality straight pins with glass heads),
- pincushion, seam ripper, seam gauge, needles for hand sewing
- Rotary cutter and extra blade
- Cutting mat
- 6x24 ruler
- Calendar Quilts pattern by Kim Schaefer
- Small sharp scissors suitable for cutting paper
- Small iron and ironing pad
- Pencil
- 1 yard fusible web, Lite Steam-A Seam works best
- 1/3 yard total assorted reds for pieced background and appliqué pieces
- 1/2 yd total assorted blacks for pieced border and appliqué pieces
- 1/4 yd total assorted golds, oranges, purples and blues for appliqué pieces
- 1/3 yard light for snowman
- 1/8 yard total assorted lights for snowflakes
- 1/8 yard stripe for scarf
- 1 yd for backing and binding
- 24"x32" batting
- Thread to match your project

Before coming to class: please cut and sew your background and border pieces before coming to class. During class we will be tracing, cutting and fusing your quilt top.

Class Policies:

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
