***Bobbin work, Crazy Patch, Binding, Piping,
Buttonholes and Button/Charm attachment***

Supplies you will need:

- Sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a Bernina.
- Extra machine needles size 80's and if you are going to be working with Metallic thread or other specialty threads you will probably want #80 Topstitching needles
- Basic sewing kit to include: chalk marker, water-soluble fabric marking pen, long strong straight pins (invest in quality straight pins with glass heads), pincushion, seam ripper, seam gauge, needles for hand sewing
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Feet :
 - #20 (open toed) Appliqué Foot
 - #10 Edge Stitch Foot
 - Walking foot with quilting guides
 - Button hold foot
 - #18 Button /Charm sew on foot
 - #12 Piping Foot (Bulky Overlock)
 - Binder Attachment with instructions (optional)
- Fabric requirements; if you are making for an 830, 820 or an extra large machine you will need more of the tone on tone, lining, and batting
 - 1 yard of main fabric either plain or tone on tone.
 - 1 yard of muslin for lining
 - 1 yard of batting (either warm and natural or thermolam)

- Many, Many scraps (I used strip scraps I had on hand. They need to be anywhere from 2" wide to 4" wide you will also need several other scraps that are not strips for the crazy patch sewing
- We will be discussing pockets and linings at the first class
- Thread: You will need general sewing thread in a neutral color for sewing construction, and decorative thread to do all of the outer stitching. You will also need one spool of Candlelight thread. This will be going in the bobbin for bobbin work.
- 3 empty bobbins and an extra bobbin case if you have one.
- 4 yards of ¼ inch thick pre made piping (I do not think we will have time to make piping but if you want to make your own piping you will need 6/32 in filler cord 1 fat quarter of fabric and a zipper foot. I will teach you how I make it.
- Decorative buttons and some sewing charms if you like
- Glasses or magnifier if needed
- Pencil and paper for taking notes

Before coming to class:

- If you are not bringing the machine you are making the cover for you will need to take several measurements of the machine. Using a cloth tape measure, measure from the table top up the end across the top and down the right hand side. Remember this is a box so bring the tape straight up on the left side. You will also need to measure the width from the table to the top of the machine, across the top from front to back at the widest parts of the machine, You will also need the width from left to right along the front. Remember to be generous because this will have batting and you want it to be a little loose fitting.
- You will also want to sew out some of your decorative stitches and be sure to write down their numbers and any changes you make to them so you will remember when it is time to sew them.

Class Policies:

- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
