### Supplies you will need:

- Sewing machine & embroidery module in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a Bernina.
- #80 Universal machine needles
- Basic sewing kit to include: **chalk marker** in a color that will show up on your fabric, water-soluble fabric marking pen, long strong straight pins (invest in quality straight pins with glass heads), scissors
- Rotary cutter and mat, 6 inch square ruler
- Stiletto
- **“Sensational Sashiko” design pack by Kenny Kreations**
- In April, you will need your machine and embroidery module, and in May, you will need your #10 edge stitch foot, multipurpose foot, and possibly your #20 open-toed foot, as well as your tray table and all accessories
- Paper and pencil for note-taking
- Gold metallic or a metallic thread that will go well with your fabric. In May, you will need construction thread that matches the fabric.
- Heavy Cut Away stabilizer (if you are using a dark fabric, you might want black stabilizer)
- Fabric:
  - 1 yard of fabric for the outside (I used washable cotton velvet). You will have some left over, but better to have too much than to run out.
  - 1 yard of cotton or fabric of your choice for the lining (make it decorative)

**Before coming to class:**

- Cut your outside fabric into 6 inch strips that run along the selvedge. Be sure to remove the selvedge.
- You will need to load approximately 10-15 designs to your machine or USB stick or remember to bring your CD reader or computer
- This is a two-part class. We will do embroideries in the first session and then we will construct the bag in the second.

**Class Policies:**

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.

- Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
