**Supplies you will need:**

- Sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a Bernina.
- Basic sewing kit to include: chalk marker, water-soluble fabric marking pen, long strong straight pins (invest in quality straight pins with glass heads), pincushion, seam ripper and extra machine needles
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**Items needed for class:**

- Cutting mat, preferably 17" x 23"
- Rotary cutter
- 7" x 24" ruler
- Seam ripper
- Book, Start Quilting, 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition, by Alex Anderson
- Fabric
  - Dark color, 1/3 yard
  - Medium color, 1/3 yard
  - Light color, 1 yard
  - Binding, 1/3 yard
  - Backing, 1 yard with no borders, 1¼ yard with borders
  - Adding borders:
    - Small, inner border, ¼ yard, you will need 4 strips cut 1½" wide
    - Large, outside border, 5/8 yard, you will need 4 strips cut 4 ½" wide
- Thread to match project and at least two bobbins filled with project thread.
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- **You will not need** your machine or Fabric for the first class. We will be talking about fabric choices in the first class. You will need Your ruler, Mat, and rotary cutter.
