



8 Series Project Decorative Stitches Quilt

Friday, May 25th & June 15th

Supplies you will need:

- 830 machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. **Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book.** It will be helpful in selecting the decorative stitches you will be using
- Extra machine needles
- Basic sewing kit to include: chalk fabric marking tool, long strong straight pins (invest in quality straight pins with glass heads)
- A ruler that is at least 6" x 24" for marking the fabrics
- You will need to bring threads that go with your fabric or contrast/compliment depending on your own personal taste. I used 12 different colors to get a large variety of design. **For the second class** you will need construction thread
- Feet: for the first class you will need your #20D foot for all of the decorative stitching. **For the second class:** you will need your #37D or #57D for the construction of the blocks and the quilt.
- Fabric – 7/8 yard of dark for the decorative stitches and 1 1/8 yards of the print that you will be using for blocks and borders. You will need to have the 10 1/2" dark strips cut before coming to the first class.
 - Cut 2 – 10 1/2" strips the width of the fabric of a solid (black) for the decorative stitches to go on. Please make sure that your threads will show up.
 - Cut 4 strips 1 1/4" for inner border of dark
 - Cut 2 strips 10 1/2" by width of fabric of the print fabric
 - Cut 4 strips 3 1/2" by width of fabric for the outer border
 - Backing will be discussed at the first class (you will need approx 1 1/4 - 1 1/2 yards for the backing and 1/2 yard for the binding)
- Stabilizer –Ultra Clean 'n' Tear for the stabilizer and for some of the stitches you might need two layers. If you have long pieces of this

stabilizer that are scraps you will want to bring them also as we may be able to use them for this project.

- Scissors for clipping threads
- ***For the second class*** You will need a rotary cutter, ruler Preferably a 10 ½" square, and a mat as you will be doing quite a bit of cutting

Class Policies:

- Classes must be paid for at time of registration. One week cancellation notice required for refund or credit fees.
- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
- As a courtesy to others, please turn off cell phones during class.
- Loaner machines are available for \$10.00 rental fee at time of registration.
