



Thread Painting

Supplies you will need:

- Sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a Bernina.
- Basic sewing kit to include: chalk marker, water-soluble fabric marking pen, long strong straight pins (invest in quality straight pins with glass heads), scissors, ruler, pincushion, seam ripper, seam gauge, needles for hand sewing and extra machine needles.
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Quilting safety pins to pin the quilt sandwich together.
- Quilting gloves are a wonderful option.
- Smoke invisible thread. Gold metallic thread for center.
- Panel of your choice.
- ½ yard for border,
- 1/3 yard for binding
- 1 yard for back
- ¼ yard black for stopper, cut into 1.5" strips
- 1 ¼ yard batting

Before coming to class:

- Cut batting into 26" x 42" and another piece larger than your flower.
- Cut 4 borders at 3" wide each. Binding is cut x 4 2.5" strips.

Class Policies:

- It is important to have all your materials before class begins and to have your sewing machine set up and ready to sew. Our teachers make every effort to start on time.
- All brands of sewing machines and sergers are welcome.
