Supplies you will need:

- Sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot control, slide on tray and a new needle. Be sure to bring your sewing machine instruction book if you are sewing on something other than a BERNINA.
- Basic sewing kit to include: chalk marker, water-soluble fabric marking pen, long strong straight pins (invest in quality straight pins with glass heads), pincushion, seam ripper, seam gauge, needles for hand sewing and extra machine needles.
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Covey of Quail machine appliqué pattern by Quilt Design Northwest
- 1 fat quarter light fabric
- 1 fat quarter medium print
- 1 fat quarter dark print
- ¼ yd fabric for border #2
- 3/8 yd fabric for border #3,
- ¾ yd if you want 6" borders
- ½ yd fusible web, I like Lite Steam-A-Seam
- 1 yd fabric for backing
- 40x40 piece of batting
- 3/8 yd fabric for binding
- 6x24 ruler
- Small sharp scissors with comfortable handles
- Size 60/8 sewing machine needles
- Invisible thread—I like YLI Wonder thread
- Thread stand (optional)
- Neutral sewing thread for bobbin
- Quilting glove (optional)
- Pencil for tracing pattern
- Open toed free motion foot

You will not need to bring your sewing machine for the first class
