



## Patternista Ornament

### Supplies you will need:

- Fabric scissors
- Thread
- 6" Styrofoam ball
- Pins – ½ pound of #17 plain steel pins, sometimes called dressmaker pins. Also, colored glass head pins, colored map tacks, decorative upholstery tacks
- Assorted sequins of varied sizes, so one can be layered on another, i.e. shimmery iridescent sequin layered on a larger flat-colored sequin. May use novelty sequins shaped like half-moons, stars & flowers.  
**Note:** Instructor will have an assortment of sequins with her in class, that she will share.
- Assorted beads – because of its size, the head of a standard pin covers up the color of a standard seed bead (11). Slightly larger beads (6) are more effective but their holes are too big for a standard pin. Use a small seed bead to prevent the pin from slipping through: insert a pin through a seed bead through a larger bead. The seed bead color can be the same or contrast with the larger bead. **Note:** Instructor will have an assortment of beads with her in class, that she will share.
- One dollmaker's needle (about 5" long)
- Plastic loop or ring for hanging
- Bead tray or small dishes
- Consider method for bead salvage at end of project (ex. Small baggies)
- Fabric – One ball needs 6 motifs, including the small stars along the selvages. 2/3 yard Patternista Panel.
