

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-8

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF COMMERCE TO CHANGE WARD BOUNDARIES.

WHEREAS, Chapter 2, Section 1-202 of the Ordinances of the City of Commerce provides that the City of Commerce be divided into four (4) wards, as described therein; and

WHEREAS, Title 11 O.S. Section 20-102 provides that a change of ward boundaries may be proposed at any time by a resolution of the municipal governing body;

WHEREAS, the City of Commerce, by and through the Mayor and pursuant to the City Charter of the City of Commerce, Oklahoma, has determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Commerce to change to ward boundaries to provide for a more equal division of registered voters within each ward.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF COMMERCE, OKLAHOMA:

The City of Commerce Ward Boundaries shall be changed as set out in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.
