Dear Garden City Property Owner:

As you may be aware we are in the beginning of the run off season around Bear Lake, which may include some flooding of private property. We did experience some flood issues last week during some warm weather. The temperature is slightly colder so the flooding has subsided, but we also received more snow, which will increase the flooding danger.

Garden City is trying to be pro-active to reduce the affects of the flooding that we may see in the valley. We have purchased sand bags, sand, and tools to help fill the sand bags. We have set up an area where people can come and use the tools and fill sand bags if needed. If you need sand bags they are located at the Garden City Office in the back of the pool building. The sand is behind the pool building. Please fill out the sign-up sheet, so we will know where people are experiencing flooding. Leave the tools in the room with the sand bags and please only take enough sand bags to protect your property so that we will have enough for everyone.

Rich County, in conjunction with other Northern Utah Counties, will be implementing an emergency notification service that will be free to you. The service uses various methods of communication to phone, text and email to provide you critical information such potential flooding. In order to participate please fill out the enclosed slip with your information and return it to our office in the enclosed stamped envelope. You will then be notified during emergency situations. This is important information as it will allow us to contact you if we find a problem with this year's run off. Your information will be treated confidentially and never given out without your permission.
