Town of Garden City Request for Bid

The Town of Garden City will be accepting sealed bids for mag water on roads as outlined below. This work will include the following:

- Mag water on 250 E Loop (Hodges/Real Beach Subdivisions, 20' x .8 mile
Estimated: 4800 gallons
- Mag water on 75 North on the south east side 20' x .1 mile
Estimated: 800 gallons
- Mag water on 75 North on the north west side 20' x .1 mile
Estimated: 800 gallons
- Mag water on 200 North on the north west side 20' x .1 mile
Estimated: 800 gallons
- Calder and Negus Road, 700 W Logan Road 10' x .6 mile
Estimated: 2000 gallons
- Mag water Hodges Canyon Road from Pavement to Sweetwater turn off. 20' x .8 mile
Estimated: 4800 gallons
- Mag water trail head parking lot 270' x 170'
Estimated: 3000 gallons
- Mag water road to & around Treatment Plant 20' x .5 mile
Estimated: 2000 gallons
- US 89 KOA to 500 South on west side of road 8' x 2 miles
Do not do by the Church Estimated: 3000 gallons
- US 89 KOA to 600 South on east side of road 8' x 2 miles
Do not do by the Church Estimated: 3000 gallons

The winning bidder must provide and include in bid all material, equipment and labor to complete the project.

If you are interested in bidding on this project please submit your sealed bid to the Garden City Office, 69 N. Paradise Parkway, bldg B. Bids will be based on a point system of the following categories; 1) Price, 2) Past performance/quality and complete related projects, 3) Schedule. Preference may be given to local contractors. Winning Bidder must provide copy of a current business license, and proof of workers compensation and liability insurance coverage.

Bids will be accepted until 3:00 p.m. on May 30, 2012 and may be turned in to the Garden City Office. Bids will be opened at 3:05 p.m., May 30, 2012. Project must be completed between June 15th and June 30th, 2012, weather permitting. This project will be under the direction of the Garden City Public Works Department and the Council Member Huefner.
