Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 3/8 yd Medium Blue Tonal (Y0590-30)
- 5/8 yd White Large Floral (Y0591-1)
- 1 1/4 yd Dark Blue Large Floral (Y0591-31)
- 1/2 yd Medium Blue Floral (Y0592-30)
- 1 1/4 yd White Small Floral (Y0593-1)
- 2 3/4 yd Dark Blue Small Floral (Y0593-31)
- 1/4 yd Medium Blue Geo (Y0594-30)
- 5 yd Backing of your choice

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Medium Blue Tonal cut:

48 - 2 1/2" squares

From the White Large Floral cut:

6 - 8 1/2" square

From the Dark Blue Large Floral cut:

7 - 5 1/2" x WOF

From the Medium Blue Floral cut:

24 - 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles

From the White Small Floral cut:

48 - 2 1/2" x 3 1/2"

96 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

From the Dark Blue Small Floral cut:

8 - 2 1/2" x WOF (binding)

3 - 18 1/4" squares, cut twice diagonally

2 - 9 3/8" squares, cut once diagonally

156 - 2 1/2" squares

48 - 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

48 - 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

96 - 1 1/2" squares








From the Medium Blue Geo cut:

24 - 2 1/2" squares



Flower Block - Finished Size: 12" x 12"

1. With a pencil, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 1 1/2" Dark Blue Small Floral squares. Place one of these squares on the corner of a 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" White Small Floral rectangle and sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance to within 1/4" of the seam and press open. Repeat on the other corner. Repeat to make a total of forty-eight.
2. Sew a unit from step 1 to the right and left sides of a 2 1/2" Dark Blue Small Floral square, press. Repeat to make twelve.
3. Sew a 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Dark Blue Small Floral rectangle to the bottom of a 2 1/2" Medium Blue Tonal square, press. Then sew a 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Dark Blue Small Floral rectangle to one side, press. Make a total of forty-eight.
4. Sew a unit from step 3 to the right and left sides of a unit from step 1, press. Repeat to make a total of twenty-four.
5. Watching placement, sew the units from step 4 to the top and bottom of the units from step 2, press. Make a total of twelve.
6. With a pencil, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of ninety-six of the 2 1/2" Dark Blue Small Floral squares. Place one of these squares on the right end of a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" White Small Floral rectangle, sew and trim as you did in step 1. Repeat this time putting the square on the left end of the rectangle. Repeat to make ninety-six, forty-eight of each.
7. Sew two of the units from step 6 together matching the points. Repeat to make forty-eight.
8. Sew a unit from step 7 to the right and left sides of a unit from step 5. Repeat to make twelve.
9. Sew a 2 1/2" Dark Blue Small Floral square to each end of the remaining sections from step 7, press. Sew them to the top and bottom of the units from step 8.

Alternate Block - Finished Size: 12" x 12"

1. Sew a 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Medium Blue Floral rectangle to the right and left sides of a 8 1/2" White Large Floral square and press toward the rectangle. Repeat to make six.
2. Sew a 2 1/2" Medium Blue Geo square to both ends of the remaining 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Medium Blue Floral rectangles and press toward the rectangle. Sew these units to the top and bottom of the unit from step 1 and press. Make a total of six Alternate Blocks.

Putting It Together

1. Layout the blocks in diagonal rows as shown and place a setting triangle or corner triangle at the end of each row as needed. Sew the blocks together into rows, press each row in the opposite direction. Sew the rows together, press.
2. Sew the 5 1/2" x WOF Dark Blue Large Floral strips together end to end to make one long strip, press. Sew this strip to the right side of the quilt top, press and trim excess. Repeat on the left, top and bottom of the quilt top.
3. Layer quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. Add binding to the quilt.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements, and construction directions, this does not allow for personal variations in measuring, cutting and/or sewing. Clothworks is not responsible for printing errors.
