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Materials

3/4 Yd - Race Track Print (Y0214-1)
 1/2 Yd- Black Tread Marks (Y0211-6)
 3/4 Yd- Blue Crowds (Y0215-1)
 7/8 Yd- Red Tread Marks (Y0211-4)
 (includes binding)
 3/8 Yd- Black Crowds (Y0215-6)
 1 Yd- Blue Race Cars (Y0212-1)
 1/3 Yd- Plain Black
 1/4 Yd- Plain White
 3-3/4 Yds -Blue Tossed Flags (Y0213-1)
 (backing)

Cut the Fabrics

WOF= Width of Fabric
 LOF= Length of Fabric

From the Race Track Print cut:

- 1 - 24-1/2" square

From the Black Tread Marks cut:

- 8 - 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips
- 8 - 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips
- 4 - 3-1/2" squares

From the Blue Crowds cut:

- 2 - 3-7/8" squares
- 8 - 3-1/2" squares
- 20 - 2-1/2" squares
- 4 - 3-1/2" x 30-1/2" strips.

From the Red Tread Marks cut:

- 6 - 2-1/4" x WOF strips for Binding
- 4 - 2" x 36-1/2" strips
- 2 - 3-7/8" squares.

From the Black Crowds cut:

- 4 - 2" x 36-1/2" strips

From the Blue Race Cars cut:

- 4 - 6-1/2" x 42-1/2" strips

From the Plain Black cut:

- 20 - 2-1/2" squares
- * 20 - 1-1/2" squares

From the Plain White cut:

- 16 - 2-1/2" squares
- * 16 - 1-1/2" squares

From the Blue Tossed Flags cut:

- Cut and sew together one 62" square for the backing.

Directions

Quilt Top Assembly Instructions:

- 1) Place one 2-1/2" Blue Crowds square on the left side of one 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" Black Tread Marks strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.
- 2) Place one 3-1/2" Blue Crowds square on the right side of the 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

- 3) Repeat Steps 1-2 to make four 8" Left Units total.

- 4) Place one 3-1/2" Blue Crowds square on the left side of one 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" Black Tread Marks strip, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press (fig. 6). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

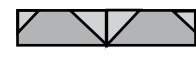

- 5) Place one 2-1/2" Blue Crowds square on the right side of the 3-1/2" x 8-1/2" strip, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (fig. 8). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.

- 6) Repeat Steps 1-2 to make four 8" Right Units total.

- 7) Refer to Figure 9 and sew together one 8" Left Unit and one 8" Right Unit to make one pieced border. Repeat to make four pieced borders total.

- 8) Using the flip and sew technique from Step 1, sew four 2-1/2" Blue Crowd squares onto the left side of four 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" Black Tread units to make four 4" Right Units total (fig. 10). Sew each unit to the right end of each pieced border (fig. 11).

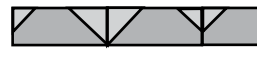

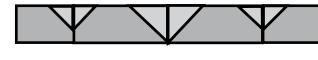

- 9) Using the flip and sew technique from Step 2, sew four 2-1/2" Blue Crowd squares onto the right side of four 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" Black Tread units to make four 4" Left Units (fig. 12). Sew each unit to the left end of each pieced border (fig. 13).

- 10) Refer to the quilt photo to sew one pieced border to each side of the 24-1/2" Race Track square.

- 11) Using the flip and sew technique from Step 2, sew four 2-1/2" Blue Crowd squares onto one corner of four 3-1/2" Black Tread squares (fig. 14). Sew one square onto each end of the remaining two pieced borders. Sew the borders to the top and bottom of the 24-1/2" Race Track square to make the quilt top.

- 12) Sew one 3-1/2" x 30-1/2" Blue crowd strip to each side of the quilt top.

- 13) Place one 3-7/8" Blue Crowd square on top of one 3-7/8" Red Tread Marks square, right side together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 15). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 16) to make two half-square triangles (Fig. 17). Repeat to make four half-square triangles total.

- 14) Sew one half-square triangle to each of the remaining two 3-1/2" x 30-1/2" Blue Crowds strips. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

- 15) Refer to Figure 18 to make four 6-1/2" Checkerboard squares from the twenty 2-1/2" Black and sixteen 2-1/2" white squares. Make four 3-1/2" Checkerboard squares from the twenty 1-1/2" Black and sixteen 1-1/2" white squares.

- 16) Sew together one 2" x 36-1/2" Red Tread Marks strip and one 2" x 36-1/2" Black Crowd Strip, lengthwise to make one 3-1/2" x 36-1/2" strip. Make four total. Refer to the quilt photo and sew one strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 3-1/2" Checkerboard block to each of the remaining two strips. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

- 17) Sew one 6-1/2" x 42-1/2" Race Car strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 6-1/2" Checkerboard block to each end of the remaining two 6-1/2" x 42-1/2" strips. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

- 18) Layer, quilt and bind as desired.

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
