FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

| Panel 1865/86 | one panel | |
|--|------------------------|--------|
| Red crackle 1863-88 | Border around panel | ½ yd |
| Red star 1861/84 | Border 1 & star points | 1 yd |
| Gold swirl 1864/44 | Border 2 | 1/2 yd |
| Cream crackle 1863-44 | Star background | ½ yd |
| Blue porthole animals 1860/63 Star center | | 1/8 yd |
| Gold birds 1862/44 | Alternate blocks | 3/4 yd |
| Border 3 | (2" squares) | |

1/8 yd each:

Blue crackle 1863-77 Cream star 1861/42 Blue birds 1862/74 Red porthole animals 1860/83 Blue swirl 1864/11

Animals on blue 1859/74 Outer border 1 yd Backing Animals on cream 1859-34 4 yds Binding Green star 1861/68 5% yd

CUTTING INSTRUCTION

Seams are $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press seams as you piece the quilt. **Center panel will be approximately 24" x 42/44" (We will add border strips to make it measure 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".)

 From red crackle print cut (4) 4" strips x width of fabric (wof)

**Sew the strips to sides of center panel, then to the top and bottom. Trim down so that this unit measures 30 ½" x 48 ½".

Note: Save extra pieces as you go along and cut into 2 ½" squares for even more variety in border 3.

STARS (Make 10)

From tan crackle print (background)

- (40) 2" x 2" squares
- (40) 2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

From red star print

• (80) 2 3/8" x 2 3/8" squares

From blue animal faces print

(10) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares (fussy cut)

ALTERNATE BLOCKS

From gold bird print

(10) 6 ½" x 12 ½" rectangles


BORDERS

Inner border #1

- Cut (6) 2 ½" x wof strips from red star print, piece 2 ½" strips to measure:
- (2) 2 1/2" x 46 1/2" strips and

(2) 2 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips

Inner border #2




Inner border #3

- Cut (7) 2 ½" x wof from gold swirl, piece 2 ½" strips to measure:
- (2) 2 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips and
- (2) 2 1/2" x 68 1/2" strips

Outer border #4

- Cut (8) 4 ½" x wof strips from blue animal print, piece 4 ½" strips to measure
- (2) 4 1/2" x 62 1/2" strips and
- (2) 4 1/2" x 72 1/2" strips

Construction of the quilt top Star Blocks



Draw a line diagonally corner to corner on the wrong side of the red star print squares. Place the 2" square on the 2" x 3 ½" rectangle background fabric. Sew on the line. Trim ¼" from the seam. Repeat this on the other side of the rectangle to create the star points. Make four Add 2" squares background to two of these units. The center is the 3 ½" square blue animal face print. Piece the stars as shown. Press seams in opposing directions
Make 10 star blocks.

STAR BORDER

Sew the side borders: three 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" gold bird rectangles alternating with two star blocks; add to each side of the quilt top.

Sew the top and bottom borders alternating three star blocks with 2 gold bird rectangles; add to the quilt top.

BORDERS Press seams toward borders.

- Sew inner border #1, red star print 2½" x 60½" pieces to the sides of the quilt top, then add the 2½" x 46½" pieces to the top and bottom.
- Border #2 is pieced with the 2 ½" squares of all the assorted prints. The sides have 32 squares each and the top and bottom have 25. Sew these borders to the quilt; first to the sides then top and bottom.
- The third inner border is pieced using the gold swirl print. Add to the quilt top as before. The side pieces are 2 ½" x 68½" and the top and bottom measure 2 ½" x 54 ½"
- Now add the outer border. Sew $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips of blue animal print to sides and then add the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces to the top and bottom.
- Layer, baste and quilt. Cut (8) strips 2 ½" x wof for binding. Piece together for continuous binding.
