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## ~ Cottage Charm ~ Size: 78 3/4" x 94"

### Cutting Instructions:

From the **Red tonal** fabric, cut:

17 - 2 1/4" strips. Cut into 49 - 2 1/4" x 14"

From the **Red floral** fabric, cut:

20 - 3 1/2" squares

From the **Cream print**, cut:

11 - 2 1/4" x 44" strips. Cut into 194 - 2 1/4" squares

From the **Yellow print**, cut:

7 - 2 1/4" x 44" strips and set aside for borders

4 - 2" x 44" and cut into 80 - 2" squares

From the **Blue floral** fabric, cut:

8 - 6 1/2" x 44" strips

From the **Pink binding** print, cut:

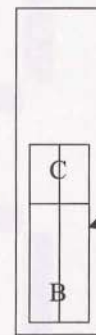
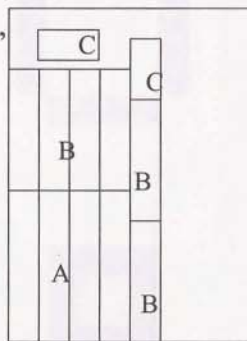
3" wide strips cut on the bias totaling 340" in length when sewn together

From the **15 fat quarters** cut the following pieces: Save the leftovers and cut 5 of each set as shown:

A: 2 1/4" x 10 1/2"

B: 2 1/4" x 7"

C: 2 1/4" x 3 1/2"



(Don't cut any of these sizes out of the yellow prints)

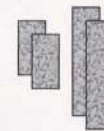
### Assembly Instructions

1. Draw a diagonal line across the back side of the yellow 2" squares. Lay the square right sides together with the red floral 3 1/2" square. Sew on the line and cut off the outer corner, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Repeat on the remaining 3 corners.

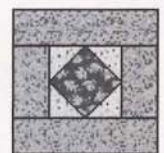

2. Set aside 20 sets of 3 1/2" and 7" lengths as shown (sets are all from the same fabric). Border the block using the 3 1/2" and 7" lengths as shown. (You will end up with a few yellow strips next to the yellow center block. If this bothers you, cut a few extra sets from the blue floral border fabric like I did - see color picture.)

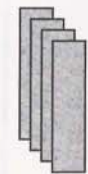
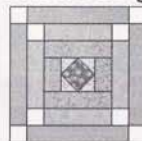

3. Arrange the remaining 7" lengths into sets as shown. Sew cream print 2 1/4" squares to the ends of half of these lengths. Sew to the block as shown.

4. Repeat Step 3, this time using the 10 1/2" lengths.



5. Sew the blocks together into rows, along with the red 2 1/4" x 14" and the remaining cream 2 1/4" squares. Refer to the color picture as needed. The quilt should now measure 63 1/4" x 78 1/2"

6. Sew all of the yellow print strips together end to end. Cut off two lengths at 78 1/2" and sew to the sides of the quilt. Cut off two lengths at 63 1/4". Add the remaining cream 2 1/4" squares to the ends and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew all of the blue floral strips together end to end. Cut off two lengths at 82" and sew to the sides of the quilt. Cut off two lengths at 78 3/4" and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Quilt as desired and bind using the bias cut pink strips.

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
