

**fabric requirements for 1 placemat**

1/8 yard of heart fabric

1/8 yard of background

1/8 yard of border

1/2 yard of backing (you will have lots left over)

batting

## cutting

### 3 1/2" squares

- 2 - heart fabric
- 2 - background fabric

### 3 7/8" squares to make into half square triangles

- 4 - heart fabric
- 4 - background fabric

### 1 1/2" strip of border fabric

- 2 - strips

### 2" squares

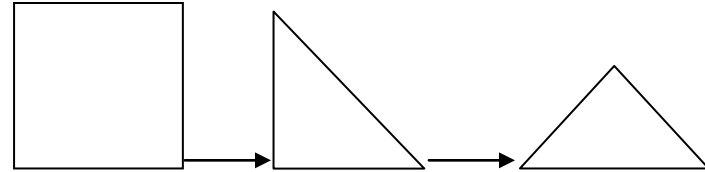
- approximately 40 of assorted fabrics

## sewing

1. lay 3 7/8" square right sides together and mark corner to corner.
2. stitch 1/4" on either side of the marked line.
3. cut on marked line. press open
4. lay out pieces to form heart.
5. stitch squares together to make rows. stitch rows to make rectangle.
6. add border. (mitered corners - leave extra on both pieces of border strip. stitch only to the corner or placemat. folding the placemat lay extra strips right side together. holding strips together open up placemat flat to form the 45° angle.

press down. fold placemat again to show line of angle. stitch on line)

7. prairie points- fold 2" square in half diagonally then fold in half again pressing each time.



pin with point inside and longest edge on edge of placemat. overlap corners slightly. baste prairie points onto placemat.

8. cut batting and back to fit.

9. layer and stitch leaving a hole for turning.

10. turn and close hole by topstitching all around top.

11. finish by quilting placemat.
