Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

2/3 yd or 1 panel - Summertime (10174-1)

1/3 yard - Blue Geranium Flowers (10176-1)

1/4 yard - Green Geranium Flowers (10176-3)

 $\frac{1}{2}$ yard - Red Geranium Flowers (10176-5)

1/4 yard - White Berry Toss (10179-2)

 $\frac{1}{4}$ yard - Blue Watermelon Toss (10178-4)

5/8 yard - Summertime Stripe (Y0175-2)

1 1/4 yards - Blue Large Toss (Y0177-4)

½ yard - Red Geranium Flowers (10176-5) for binding 3 1/3 yards backing (suggested Summertime Check (Y0173-2)

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Summertime panel cut: 20 1/2" square

From the Blue Geranium Flowers cut:

2 - 2 ½" x 34 ½" strips for border

2 - $2~1\!/\!_2{}''$ x $30~1\!/\!_2{}''$ strips for border

From the Green Geranium Flowers cut:

2 - 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips for border

2 - 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" strips for border

From the Red Geranium Flowers cut:

4 - 4 1/2" squares

3 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips

6 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips (binding)

From the White Berry Toss cut:

3 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips

From the Blue Watermelon Toss cut:

4 - 4 1/2" squares

From the Summertime Stripe cut:

 $4 - 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $34 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips (across the width of the fabric)

From the Blue Large Toss cut:


6 - 6 1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble Pieced Block Border Sections

1. Pair a 2 ½" x WOF Red Geranium strip right sides together with a 2 ½" x WOF White Berry Toss strip. Sew together along the length. Press the seam toward the red fabric. Cut 2 ½" slices from the combined strip. (Figure 1) Repeat to make two more strip sets from the remaining red and white strips and cut 2 ½" slices from them.



2. Sew 11 segments together to make one border section (Figure 2). Repeat to make 4 border sections. Press the seams all to one side. Set aside to assembly.



Assemble the Quilt

- 1. Sew a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Green Geranium Flower strip to the left and right sides of the panel Press the seams outward. Sew a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Green Geranium Flower strip to the top and bottom of the panel. Press the seams outward.
- 2. Sew a red/white pieced border section to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Press the seams outward. Sew a 4 ½" Blue Watermelon square to the ends of the remaining two pieced border sections. Sew one of the completed border sections to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press the seams outward.
- 3. Sew a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Blue Geranium Flower strip to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Press the seams outward. Sew a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Blue Geranium Flower strip to the top and bottom sides of the quilt center. Press the seams outward.
- 4. Sew a 4 ½" x 34 ½" Summertime Stripe strip to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Sew a 4 ½" Red Geranium Flower square to the ends of the remaining Summertime Stripe border sections. Sew the completed border sections to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press the seams outward.
- 5. Measure the length of the quilt center from the top to the bottom and piece two border strips of the Blue Large Toss 6 1/2" wide strips to that length. Sew to the left and right sides of the quilt center. Press the seams outward.
- 6. Measure the width of the quilt center with the added borders and piece two border lengths from the remaining 6 1/2" wide Blue Large Toss strips. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press the seams outward.
- 7. Layer, baste and quilt as desired. Make the binding from the Red Geranium Flower 2 ½" wide strips and apply to the quilt.
