

## Casserole Carrier

4 fat quarters

1 1/2 yards of ribbon

batting scraps

- 1. fold each fat quarter into fourths. place cutting template on folds and cut out. this should make four ovals.
- 2. take the top circle and then the inside piece of the top and fold into fourths and cut the smaller circle. then cut pieces in half.
- 3. cut 1 large batting oval and two curves pieces to match your fabric.
- 4. large ovals layer right sides together and batting, stitch, leaving opening, turn and then stitch over entire oval.
- 5.curve pieces turn straight ends under and hem. Then layer together and stitch the top curve and the large bottom, turn right side out, and stitch all over leaving a casing at top for ribbon.
- 6. place curves on top of large oval and stitch around the edge. (you could also cover this with a bias binding if you enjoy bias bindings)
- 7. thread ribbon through the curve pieces and stitch together. Hide intersection in the casings.
- 8. enjoy your casserole carrier.
