Join the 2-5/8" DARK half-equare triangles and the 4-3/4" LIGHT quarter-equare triangles to make 68 Flying Geese units as shown.



Prese the seams toward the DARK triangles.

The unite should measure 2-1/4" x 4" (raw edge to raw edge) when sewn.

STITCHING TIPS FOR "FLYING GEESE" UNITS 1. Join left-hand triangle: Match points (A) and bottom edges; sew in direction of arrow. Press seam toward smaller

2. Join right-hand triangle. Start at arrow. Your 1,4" seam should EXACTLY intersect the 90-degree angle where the two smaller triangles meet, as in the magnified portion of the drawing. Adjust the position of the loose triangle until the seam lines up correctly. Take a few stitches, then match points (8) and finits attiching the seam. Press seam toward smaller triangle.
