Quilting Skill: Beginner • Finished Quilt Size: 76" x 76" • Block count and size: 9 blocks 14" x 14", 4 corners blocks 6" x 6"

## Fabric Requirements and Cutting Guide

Note: In cutting "wof" means width of fabric
Fabric A 3515-0111 1-1/2 yards
Cut (7) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ wof strips, sew together end-to-end then cut (4) $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 64-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ outside borders
Fabric B 3516-0111 1-1/4 yards
Fussy cut (5) $8-1 / 2$ " squares, centering on a rose motif in each square
Cut (6) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof strips, sew together end-to-end then cut into (2) side borders $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders and (2) top/bottom borders $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 64-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric C 3516-0173 1 yard
Fussy cut (4) $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, centering on a rose motif in each square
Cut (7) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof strips, sew together end-to-end then cut into (2) side borders $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders and (2) top/bottom borders 2-1/2" x 58-1/2"
Fabric D 3517-0111 1-1/4 yard
Cut (8) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips from length of fabric, recut into (24) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14-1 / 2$ " sashings
Cut (4) 6-1/2" squares
Fabric E 3518-0111 $1 / 2$ yard
Cut (4) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof strips, recut into (32) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ " rectangles
Fabric F 3519-0111 $1 / 2$ yard
Cut (4) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof strips, recut into (40) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ " rectangles
Fabric G 3520-0111 $1 / 2$ yard
Cut (3) $4-1 / 2$ " $x$ wof strips, recut into (20) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Fabric H 3521-0111 1/3 yard
(Cut 2) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ wof strips, recut into (16) $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Fabric I 3522-0111 1/3 yard
Cut (2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ wof strips, recut into (16) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Cut (1) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof strip, recut into (16) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Fabric J 3522-0173 1/3 yard
Cut (2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ wof strips, recut into (20) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Cut (1) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ wof strip, recut into (20) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Fabric K 3523-0111 1 yard
Cut (2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ wof strips, recut into (16) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Cut (8) 2-1/4" $x$ wof strips, sew together end-to-end for binding
Backing 3517-0111 4-1/2 yards
Cut into 2 equal pieces and sew together selvedge to selvedge

## Instructions




Block One


Block Two

Refer to the block diagrams. Block One: position a fabric G $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square in opposite corners of a fabric B $8-1 / 2 "$ square. Sew in a diagonal line from corner to corner on each fabric $G$ square. Trim $1 / 4^{" 1}$ from stitching line, fold out triangle and press. Repeat in the remaining two corners to make the center of the block. Sew a fabric F $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ " rectangle to each side of a fabric J $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Make 4 units. Sew one of these units to each side of the block center. Sew a fabric J 3-1/2" square to each end of the remaining two units then sew these units to the remaining two sides of the block. Make 5 blocks.
Block Two: position a fabric H 4-1/2" square in opposite corners of a fabric C $8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew in a diagonal line from corner to corner on each fabric H square. Trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from stitching line, fold out triangle and press. Repeat in the remaining two corners to make the center of the block. Sew a fabric E $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to each side of a fabric $11-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Make 4 units. Sew one of these units to each side of the block center. Sew a fabric $\mid 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square to each end of the remaining two units; sew these units to the remaining two sides of the block. Make 4 blocks.
Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram (Page 3) for the placement of Blocks One and Blocks Two. Sew the blocks together in 3 rows of 3 blocks each, separating the blocks with 4 fabric $D$ sashings. Make 3 rows.
Sew 4 fabric $\mathrm{K} 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and 3 fabric D $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashings into a sashing row. Make 4 rows.
Sew the fabric C $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew the fabric C $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to the top/bottom of the quilt top.
Sew the fabric B $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew the fabric B $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 64-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to the top/bottom of the quilt top.
Make the corner blocks. Position a fabric $K 3-1 / 2^{" ~ s q u a r e ~ i n ~ o p p o s i t e ~ c o r n e r s ~ o f ~ a ~ f a b r i c ~ D ~} 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from stitching line, fold out triangle and press. Repeat in remaining two corners. Make 4 blocks.
Sew a fabric A $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 64-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to opposite sides of the quilt top. Sew a corner block to each end of the remaining fabric A borders, then sew these borders to the top/bottom of the quilt to complete.
Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt the layers together. Bind to finish the outside edges.
