

# Flying Geese

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This is a simple way to make four geese at one time. I think that it is much easier than any other technique!

1. Determine the size of the needed Flying Geese.
2. Decide the fabric will be the geese and which fabric will be the sky.
3. Cutting instructions - Geese Fabric - (inside) 1 large square that is  $1 \frac{1}{4}$  larger  
Sky Fabric - (outside) 4 squares that is  $\frac{7}{8}$  larger  
draw line from corner to corner of each
4. Sewing instructions - a. lay the large square right side up. place two of the four small squares right side down on the opposite corners.  
b. stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the line. cut on the line.  
c. press the seams to the dark.  
d. lay one the squares right side down on the top of the sewn unit.  
e. stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the line. cut on the line.  
f. press the sky to the outside.  
g. repeat with the other side and last sky square. You will get four geese at a time.
