

Embroidery

When embroidering on a Terry Cloth bathrobe and the loops are showing through the embroidery.

What can you do?

Cut a square of Solvy or water soluble stabilizer, and place it over the area to be stitched. Pin or baste the outer edges to hold it in place. After embroidery, it can be gently pulled away, and if any remains, can be removed with a wet cloth or cotton swab.

Metallic thread Problems

If when machine embroidering with metallic thread, the thread breaks frequently, try changing the direction of the spool. If the thread is going over the spool, turn it so the thread comes under the spool. This will change the "twist" of the thread, and many times this will solve your thread breaking problems. If that does not work, place the upright spool pin in the hole on the top of your machine. Then place your large spool cap on the spool pin, then the spool. Also try to slow down your motor speed.

A metallic needle or Inspira 75 with a large eye works especially well for metallic threads because the top of the eye of this needle is rounded and does less shredding of the thread
