SUPPLY LIST FOR HEIRLOOM BLOCKS - (FIRST 3 BLOCKS)

1 yd batiste or fine cotton

2 7/8 yd of 3/8" lace insertion

1 1/8 yd of 1" lace edging

7/8 yd of 5/8" lace edging

7/8 yd of entredeux

Wash away stabilizer

Glass head pins

Lace shaping board

"Roxanne Glue Baste-It" or glue stick

100 wing needle or 120 Universal needle for hemstitches

Size 70 or 75 needle

Embroidery machine needle

60w fine embroidery thread (Mettler), color to match laces& fabric

Rayon or Poly decorative threads of choice for machine embroidery

Spray starch

Normal sewing supplies, such as scissors, rulers, etc.

Sewing & embroidery machine

"Heirloom Quilts by Machine" book by Martha Pullen (may use mine for 1st class)

A mini iron is great for lace shaping, if you have one. I'll have one to use during the class.

SUPPLY LIST FOR PLEATER CLASS

If you don't have a pleater, I will have mine to show you how the principles of a pleater work.

Pleater

Threads - quilting thread or poly sewing thread (if the fabric is fine, the poly thread will not leave holes when removed). Don't select a dark or vibrant color, as it may bleed into a light fabric.

Wooden dowel for rolling fabric - $\frac{1}{4}$ " or $\frac{1}{2}$ " diameter or whatever you have

Piece of cotton fabric

Scissors

Needle threader

Masking tape will be provided



SUPPLY LIST FOR GEOMETRIC SMOCKING

"Joy of Smocking" book

Crewel/Embroidery needles - sizes 6, 7 or 8

Milliner's needle (optional)

Small scissors

Several colors of floss

Pleated piece of fabric will be provided

You will be doing a sampler piece to learn the various stitches.

For your info: A lap desk (bean bag underneath) is great for resting your smocking piece on while you are doing your stitches

Fabric for binding



Supply List Car Visor Caddy:

Scraps of fabric to equal $\frac{1}{2}$ yard, 4 different colors

OR

$\frac{1}{4}$ yd color #1

7 x12 piece color #2

5 $\frac{1}{4}$ x 12 piece color #3

4 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 9 piece color #4

12 inch zipper

7 inch zipper

16 inches $\frac{3}{8}$ inch black elastic

$\frac{1}{4}$ yd woven fusible interfacing

Wonder tape

Marking pen, blue water soluble or iron off

Supply List Little Details:

Wing needle or a large topstitching needle #100 or #110

Hand sewing needle

Water soluble stabilizer

Piping foot or zipper foot

Serger Heirloom Bow Tie Quilt:

2 $\frac{1}{2}$ yds white batiste

$\frac{1}{2}$ yd gingham 60 inch wide, or 2/3 yd 45 inch wide

$\frac{1}{2}$ yd solid to co-ordinate with gingham 60 inch wide, or 2/3 yd 45 inch wide

2/3 yd 4 inch wide embroidered insertion

1 $\frac{1}{3}$ yd embroidered beading

Batting size 45" x 60 "

Embroidery thread to match solid color above

3 spools white serger thread

Water soluble blue marking pen

Serger Purse with 3 Flaps:

$\frac{3}{4}$ yds black silk dupioni

9 x 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch piece thin batting

One 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ x 32 inch strip of contrasting silk dupioni for ruffle (if desired)

One 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ x 18 bias strip of contrasting silk dupioni for piping

1 -1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yard decorative cord for strap

12 - $\frac{1}{2}$ inch to 5/8 inch black buttons

3 spools black serger thread

Contrasting embroidery thread for pintucks and chainstitch

Iron away light marking pen

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Note: Some construction is done by sewing machine. The flap designs and basic construction is done with your serger.



Snug as a Bug Baby Bag Supply List

½ yard of outer fabric, Red Cotton Corduroy or Pique, 60" wide
½ yd contrasting fabric #1, Black and White Gingham, 60" wide
3/8 yard of contrast fabric #2, Yellow Cotton
3/8 yard of inner pocket fabric, 45" wide, red cotton
3 yds of mini piping (yellow gingham)
1-1/4 yd of spaghetti bias, yellow
1 yd of beading (**Jane can get**)
½ yd of ¼ wide Victorian edging (**Jane may have or can get**)
1-1/2 yd of 1-1/8 " folded gingham bias (black/white) (**We can make this**)
2 yds of ¼ " black picot trim or black rick rack-
½ yd of 3/8" elastic
2 yds of ½ " wide black grosgrain ribbon
½ yd of ¼ " wide black grosgrain ribbon
3-1/8 yd of 1-1/2 " wide black grosgrain ribbon
3 yds of 5/8 " wide black grosgrain ribbon
2 yds of ¾ " wide black rick rack
1 yd fusible fleece
2 cord stops
6 ¾ " buttons
7 x16 " piece of plastic canvas or blank stencil template for bottom of bag
Thread to match

Embroidery threads in the following colors:

Red
Black
White
Yellow
Avocado green

Also need to bring:

Large embroidery hoop
120 Wing or topstitch needle
3.0 twin needle
Sticky tear away stabilizer
Glue pen
Fabric marker
Basic sewing supplies
