City of Longton awarded Federal Grant

The Ks Dept of Commerce made the announcement on Jan. 19, 2012 that City of Longton was awarded \$490,672 through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program to construct a water transmission line to CQ County Rural Water Dist. #4 to purchase and transport drinking water. In addition to the



construction of the transmission line the City will replace the current water tower with a new 50,000 gallon elevated tower. The remaining funds (\$490,672) will be matched by USDA/RD and by local funds.

Our new water source will be from the Quivera Boy Scout Ranch Lake and will be treated by the Public Water Wholesale Dist. #20 of Sedan, KS.

We do not have an estimated day when to expect the project will be completed, but everyone involved with this project is working fast and hard to get good quality water to Longton. Rumor is construction bids may be let out as early as late spring of this year.
