

## Darn Easiest Lap Quilt to Make

58 x 72" approximately

### Fabric Requirements:

A - 1 yd Novelty Print or prints, it's ok to use several just don't use the same for the outer border

B - 2/3 yd Coordinating Print

C - 1/2 yd Another Coordinating Print

Inner Border - 1/2 yd Totally different but coordinating fabric

Outer Border - 1 yd Novelty fabric different than you've already used

Binding - 1/2 yd

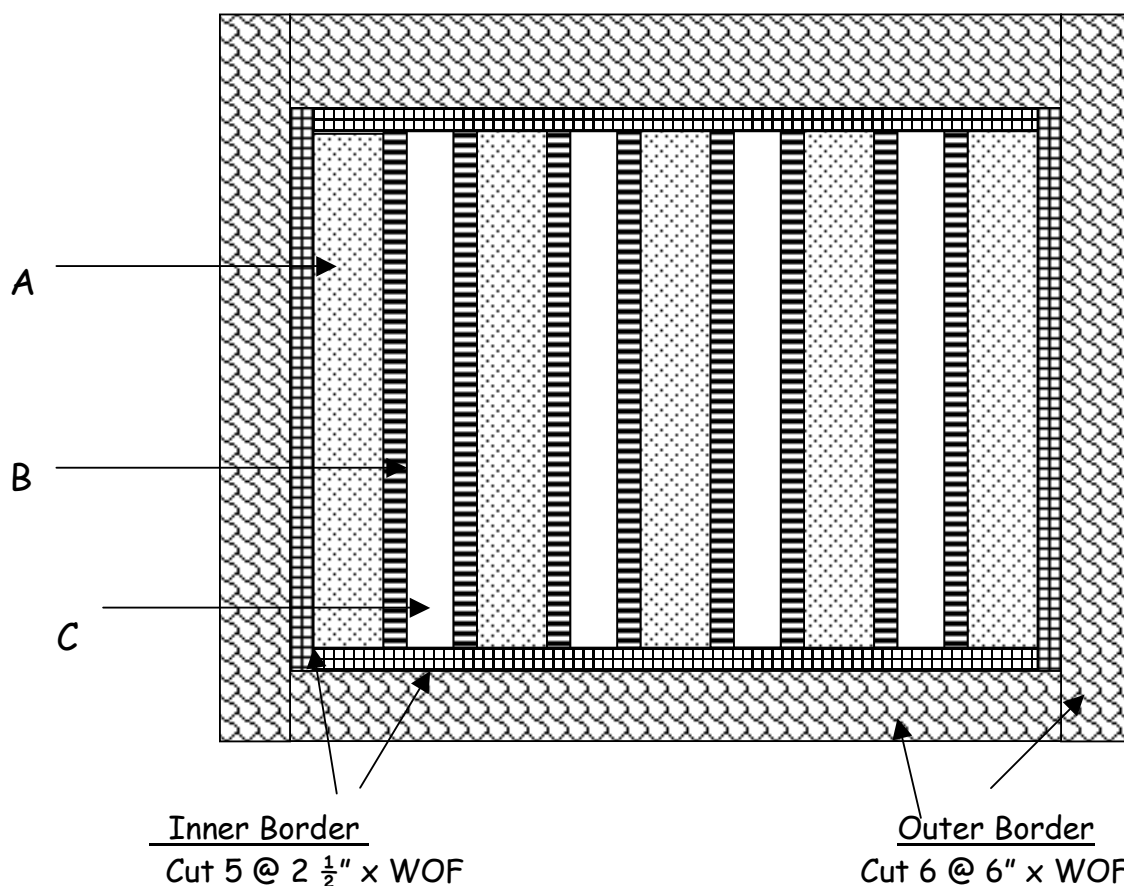
Backing - 3 1/2 yds

Center of the quilt is made with

A (5 @ 6 1/2" x WOF), B (8 @ 2 1/2" x WOF), & C (4 @ 3 1/2" x WOF) strips.

Cut selvages off & take 1/4" seam allowance. Sew together in the order below & press seam allowances under the B strips. Alternate which end you begin sewing to avoid the whole quilt shifting at an angle.

The sewing order for the center part of your quilt: A,B,C,B,A,B,C,B,A,B,C,B,A,B,C,B,A  
Square up center part by cutting off sides even & N/S sides, if necessary.



With both borders sew all strips end to then, then sew on the E/W sides on first, then press, then sew on the N/S sides & press - first the inner border, then outer. For Binding, cut 7 @ 2 1/2" x WOF & bind.
