Curves with Flanges Tote Bag Supply List

½ yard muslin

6 fabric gradation: 1/8 yard (must be full width of fabric, no fat guarters) of 5 fabrics

½ yard of background fabric (lowest fabric in photo)

½ yard of contrasting fabric for flanges (must look good on the bias)

1/4 yard for handles (may be same fabric as any of the above fabrics, except muslin)

17" x 33" of fusible interfacing

1/2 yard lining fabric

Leftover batting strips for handles

Sewing machine and supplies

Walking foot

Sack lunch

Rotary cutter, mat and 6" x 24" ruler

Thread for topstitching to blend with your 6 fabrics

LOTS of pins!

Starch (or sizing) is optional, but very helpful

Glue Baste-It is optional (for holding the flanges in place)

Iron and ironing surface (this jacket requires lots of ironing board time so it would be best if everyone has their own)
