

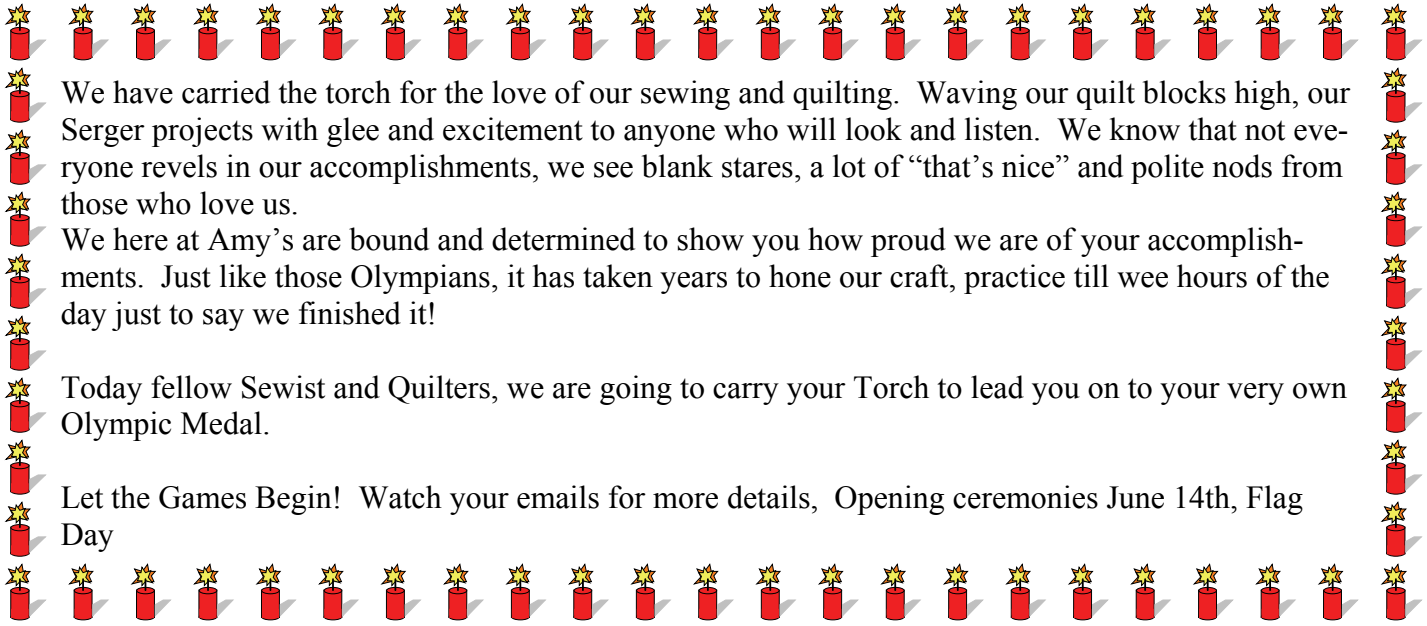


Summer Sewing Olypmics
