

EMCC Requirements for Continuous Certification

All diplomates must comply with the Policy on Medical Licensure and pass a ConCert examination during each 10-year EMCC cycle in order to maintain continuous certification.

The following chart describes diplomates' remaining requirements for maintaining certification based on the expiration year of their certificate. It assumes that diplomates pass the ConCert examination in the year in which their certificates expire and that they are involved in patient care.

Clinically inactive diplomates do not have an APP requirement. Read the full article on Clinical Activity Status.
