



## **Snowballs Pillow**

### **P10 Snowballs Patternlet**

This one's super easy using one tea towel and one 12"x16" pillow form.

Cut one 4"x18" strip of fabric for the background behind the snowmen. Cut a strip of Heat n Bond Lite to match and adhere it to the back. Cut out the three snowmen and noses backed with heat n bond lite (follow directions and pattern pieces on patternlet)

Fold the top and bottom of your towel towards the back so that they overlap in the middle. Your pillow should measure approximately 12.5" from top to bottom. Press the towel so that you can see the edges you have created. Lay your background strip where you would like it on your pillow (mine started approximately 2" from bottom of pillow) and press with iron to bond fusible web. Lay your snowmen on the background and press. Unfold the towel and stitch around all applique edges with a buttonhole or blanket stitch. Add a piece of ribbon to the top and bottom edge if desired. Fold the towel using your pressed edges as your guide, but this time fold it the opposite way so that right sides are together and the top and bottom overlap in the middle-front. Sew a 1/4" seam along the right and left sides. Turn the pillow case right sides out and insert pillow. Add buttons if you like!
