

Additional Patternlet Ideas

This sweatshirt is made using the P18 Snowman and Tree Patternlet. The small tree is achieved by leaving off the bottom tier and shortening the trunk. For the snow, simply trace the pattern piece onto the paper side of the fusible web. Then move the pattern piece over, overlapping with the part you already traced, and trace again. Trace as many times as you need to get the appropriate width.

To prepare the sweatshirt, I cut the wasteband off of the bottom to get a straight edge. Fold the bottom up approximately 1/2" and press. Fold another 1/2" and press. When you place the applique pieces onto the sweatshirt, tuck the snow just inside the folded edge.

Sew around all pieces with a blanket stitch. Sew along the bottom edge of the sweatshirt using a matching thread. Add all buttons and embellishments.
