



Patternlets Ornament Ideas

P03 Square Snowman Patternlet

Use this pattern to make cute, little ornaments for your tree or as gifts. You could even make a towel, roll it up, and attach an ornament to the front with raffia or ribbon. To make these, simply follow the directions on the pattern, except cut two of the large squares to 3 1/2" for seam allowance. I used very thin jute or hemp string, but you could also use thin ribbon. After you have appliqued the snowman's nose on one square along with his eyes and the X's for his mouth, layer the two squares with the right sides together. Put the piece of ribbon or jute between the two layers with both ends sticking out of the top of the ornament and pin in place. The "loop" of the jute should be kept in-between the two layers. Sew a 1/4" seam around the square leaving an opening at the bottom of the ornament large enough to be able to turn the ornament right sides out. Stuff the ornament with polyester fiberfill. Turn the edges of the opening under and stitch the opening closed.
