



Gourdy and Candy Corn Pillow

This one combines P08 Candy Corn and P09 Gourdy patternlets to be used on a 16"x16" pillow form. Here are the cutting instructions:

Cut 2 strips 1.5" x WOF for black outer border.

Cut 2 strips 2" x WOF for orange second border

Cut 1.5" x WOF strips from 7 different fabrics for third multi-fabric border (sew them together along the long edges and press seams open. Then cut 1.5" strips from this block.)

For the center, cut one block 7.5" x 10.5" from a neutral background and two black blocks measuring 2" x 10.5"

For the back of the pillow, cut one square 17.5" x 17.5" from a black fabric

Sew the pillow together using a 1/4" seam allowance and starting from the center... The neutral with the two black sides. Then sew a multi-colored border to each side of this block. Then the orange border to each side, and then the black border. Using the directions and pattern pieces from the patternlet, place one Gourdy in the center of the pillow and one candy corn in each corner and applique using a blanket stitch. Hand-stitch the eyebrows and mouth and add the buttons for the eyes and the jute bow. Place the piece of backing on top of the block, right sides together, and sew 1/4" around the edges leaving an opening large enough to insert your pillow form. Turn the pillow right sides out, insert pillow, and hand-sew the opening closed!
