Month 4

(Corrected 7/15/12)

Make 1

Square up to 12½"



1 - 5½" square - FG (Step 4)
1 - 7" square - FG (Step 4)
6 - 3" squares (Step 1)
For HST
4 - 2½" squares (Step 1)



1 - 3¼" square (Step 3)



1 - 5½" square - FG (Step 4)
1 - 7" square - FG (Step 4)



2 - 3" squares for HST (Step 1)
4 - 2½" squares cut in
half for Center surround (Step 3)



4 - 3" squares (Step 1)
For HST

You will need the "Fit to Be Square Ruler" by Open Gate Quilts


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Step 1 and 2 -
Half Square Triangles -

Make 8 Red and Background
Make 4 Black and Background



Make 4

Step 1 - Sew the Red and Background
3" squares together as shown. Right sides
together and 1/4" on either side of the center
line. Cut apart and press.
Square up to 2 1/2". Make 8

Step 2 - Sew the Black and Background
3" squares together as shown. Right sides
together and 1/4" on either side of the center
line. Cut apart and press. Square up to 2 1/2".
Make 4

Use the 4 - 2 1/2" Background squares to finish
assembling the above right unit. Make 4

Step 3 - Flying Geese - Make 4 of each colorway.

Using the Eleanor Burns method of assembly,
Take the 5 1/2" Square and the 7" squares and
make 4 Flying Geese of each colorway.

Square up to 2 1/2" x 4 1/2".

To do this, either use your Eleanor Burns Flying
Geese Ruler or separate the "raw" Flying Geese.
Use your ruler and cut the top 1/4" seam allow-
ance across the tip of the triangle FIRST! Turn
and cut the bottom of the triangle at 2" Then cut
the sides.



Step 1 - Center Square - Make 1

Take a center 3 1/4" square and sew black
triangles to opposite sides. You should have
2 3/4" between seams when you press the
triangles away from the
center block. If this is
correct, sew the other
2 triangles on.
Square to 4 1/2".



Make 1



Assemble the Block in rows
as shown to the right.
