

## Patchwork Garden

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

## Cut the following:

Fabric A - \*\*cut 6 - 11 1/2" x 11 1/2" squares (center designs evenly)

Fabric B - cut individual borders lengthwise:

cut 1 - 2 1/2" x 50 1/2"

cut 1 - 7 1/2" x 50 1/2"

Fabric C - cut 2 - 3 1/2" strips

Fabric D - cut 3 - 3 1/2" strips

Fabric F - cut 2 - 6 7/8" strips, subcut 10 - 6 7/8" squares cut 3 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end for 1 long strip, then subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 50 1/2"

BINDING - cut 7 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

Fabric G - cut 3 - 3 1/2" strips

**Fabric H** - \*\*cut 4 - 1" strips, subcut 6 - 1" x 11 1/2" and 6 - 1" x 12 1/2"

cut 2 - 6 7/8" strips, subcut 10 - 6 7/8" squares
Borders - cut 6 - 1 1/2" strips, sew end to end for 1 long
strip, then subcut 2 - 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" and 2 - 1 1/2" x 50 1/2"


Fabric I - \*\*cut 4 - 1" strips, subcut 6 - 1" x 11 1/2" and 6 - 1" x 12 1/2"

cut 2 - 3 1/2" strips


Borders - cut 6 - 3 1/2" strips, sew end to end, then subcut 2 - 3 1/2" x 61 1/2" and 2 - 3 1/2" x 56 1/2"

## 2. Piecing Order:


 Sew H and I 1" borders around 6 A 11 1/2" squares, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders according to the diagrams. \*\*(If A measurements are slightly different, cut H and I borders slightly larger, sew around A squares, then trim all blocks to measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".) 2. Make 20 - 6" finished (6 1/2" unf.) F/H Half Square Triangle units. First, draw a diagonal line on the back side of 10 H 6 7/8" squares. Pair H squares with F 6 7/8" squares, right sides together and match raw edges. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the diagonal line. Cut on the line to separate units. Press toward F.




3. Make 8 - 6" finished (6 1/2" unf.) **C/I** 4-Patches. First, make 2 strip sets by sewing **C** and **I** 3 1/2" strips, side by side. Press toward **I**. Subcut 16 - 3 1/2" segments. Then sew segments together for 8 4-Patches.




4. Make 12 - 6" finished (6 1/2" unf.) D/G 4-Patches. First, make 3 strip sets by sewing D and G 3 1/2" strips, side by side. Press toward G. Subcut 24 - 3 1/2" segments. Then sew segments together for 12 4-Patches.




5. Make 4 Block #1 by sewing **C/I** 4-Patches and **F/H** HST units together by rows according to the diagram.






- 6. Make 6 Block #2 by sewing **D/G** 4-Patches and **F/H** HST units together by rows according to the diagram.
- 7. Sew quilt center together by rows of blocks according to the diagram.
- 8. Sew **H** 1 1/2" borders around the quilt, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.



- 9. Sew **F** 1 1/2" x 50 1/2" to one side of both **B** borders. Then sew **B** 2 1/2" border to the TOP and sew **B** 7 1/2" to the quilt's BOTTOM according to the diagram.
- 10. Sew I 3 1/2" borders around the quilt, SIDES first, then TOP and BOTTOM borders.

11. The quilt measures approximately 56 1/2" x 67 1/2". Make backing (Fabric E) at least 6" larger than the top. Layer and baste together top, batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (Fabric F) and enjoy!!
